



Remove the guess work when purchasing a ring

The Brown & Newirth gauge works a little like a belt, simply pop the end through the buckle to form a ring shape then slip over your finger to give a comfortable fit. Make sure that it just slips back over the knuckle too, you don't want the gauge to be too tight.

To find out your perfect size simply follow our step by step guide:

- I. Download and print off our ring gauge on A4 paper (do not adjust the size of the page, we've included a handy print size check to make sure you're good to go)
- 2. Cut around the gauge tool making a neat slit at the 'buckle'
- 3. Place around your finger
- 4. Pull the end through the buckle
- 5. Pull it to fit snugly around your finger making sure it can slide back over your knuckle
- 6. The letter the arrow is pointing to is your finger size
- 7. Add half a size if purchasing a ring over 3mm wide
- When your fingers are cold, they are smaller, when hot, they are bigger
- Try to measure your fingers when your hands are not too cold and not too hot
- The gauge is for guide only and will not take into account the style of ring
